**ORDER**

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The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 18.03.2025, for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 118(1), 103(1) of BNS, 2023 in Crime No.71 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against this petitioner is that this petitioner, is husband of the deceased, got into a quarrel with his wife, attacked her with an iron rod, caused severe injuries that resulted in her death. He was arrested, a final report was filed, and the case is now pending trial. Hence, the case.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the petitioner was arrested and he is in judicial custody from 18.03.2025 and is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner was arrested on 18.03.2025 and the next date



of hearing is posted on 11.12.2025 for fixing the trial date and he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

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5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel on either side and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, and he is in judicial custody from 18.03.2025 and investigation is completed, a case committed and now pending as sessions case for fixing the trial date, and this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *learned Fast Track Mahila Court, Dharmapuri*, and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;



[b] the petitioner shall report before the concerned Court daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of three weeks;

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
