PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the Respondents to disburse the 6 percent interest for belated payment of Provident Fund, Gratuity, Pension Commutation and Earned leave surrender and consequently direct the respondents to pay the unsettled terminal benefits namely surrendered Leave Salary and 11 days last drawn salary within the stipulated time as may be fixed by this Court

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed for direction to the Respondents to disburse the 6 percent interest for belated payment of Provident Fund, Gratuity, Pension Commutation and Earned leave surrender and consequently to direct the respondents to pay the unsettled terminal benefits namely surrendered Leave Salary and 11 days last drawn salary within the stipulated time as may be fixed by this Court

2. The case of the petitioner is that he is a retired employee of the Respondents/Corporation. The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondents have to pay 6 percent interest for belated payment of Provident Fund, Gratuity, Pension Commutation and Earned leave surrender and also the unsettled terminal benefits namely surrendered Leave Salary and 11 days last drawn salary. Hence, the petitioner made a representation to the respondents on 14.10.2025. However, no action has been taken by the respondents till date. Hence this petition.



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3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that it would be suffice if this Court issues a direction to the respondents to consider the petitioner's representation and pass orders.

4. The learned Standing Counsel appearing for respondents 1 & 2 submitted that the representation of the petitioner will be considered and will pay the eligible amount with 6% interest per annum as per the earlier orders of this Court.

5. Considering the facts of the case, this Court directs the respondents to consider the representation of the petitioner and pass orders on the claim made by the petitioner within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this Order. With regard to interest for the belated payment it will be 6% interest per annum interest from the date on which the amount became due and payable till the date of disbursement. It is made clear that if the amount is not paid within the time frame fixed by this Court, the same will carry interest at the rate of 12% per annum from the date on which the amount became due and payable till the date of disbursement.



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6. With the above directions, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
