ORDER

The petitioners, apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offence under Section 296(b), 115(2), 118(1), 121(1), 132, 351(2) of BNS, 2023 r/w 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, in Crime No.186 of 2025, on the file of the respondent Police, seek anticipatory bail.

When the matter taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (CrI.Side) appearing for the respondent reported that this is the second anticipatory bail application and that the earlier anticipatory bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by this Court in CrI.O.P.No.27015 of 2025 dated 07.10.2025.

3. Now, the petitioner has filed the present anticipatory bail application that too without any change in circumstances is not entertainable. Since, there is no change in circumstances, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition stands dismissed.
