ORDER

Mr.G.Arumugam, learned Standing counsel submitted that the learned Standing counsel, who appeared for the 1st respondent University is no more and that he requires some time to take instructions from the 1st respondent University.

2. WMP No.49138 of 2025 has been filed for a direction to the 1st respondent University to open its portal for the petitioner college to enter the internal assessment marks and to pay the examination fees for the students, who were admitted during the academic year 2024-2025, pursuant to the interim order passed by this Court on 29.04.2025.

3. The subject matter of challenge in the present writ



petition pertains to the proceedings of the 1st respondent University insofar not granting affiliation for the approved intake given in GO MS.No.382 dated 21.11.2024 and for a consequential direction to the respondent University to grant conditional provisional affiliation as approved by the concerned Government Order from the academic year 2024-2025.

4. When the above writ petition was entertained by this Court, the petitioner had sought for an interim order in WMP No.12814 of 2025 and this Court passed the following interim order on 28.03.2025:-

This writ miscellaneous petition is filed for issuance of a direction to the first respondent / University to provide the petitioner College login credentials for four Under Graduate Allied Health Science Courses to register the students who had been admitted in Under Graduate Allied Health Science Courses for the academic year 2024-25, pending disposal and subject to the outcome of the writ petition.

2. The petitioner College was permitted to start Under Graduate Courses in Allied Health Science with an intake of 20 seats in each of the 4 courses vide G.O.(Ms)No.382, Health and Family Welfare (PME.1) Department dated 21.11.2024, by the third respondent. The first respondent / University in pursuance to the aforesaid Government Order passed the impugned order granting conditional provisional affiliation for starting four Allied



Health Science courses for the academic year 2024-25 reducing the intake as follows:

The petitioner aggrieved by the impugned order, filed the above writ petition.

3. The petitioner College admitted three students in B.Sc., Cardiac Technology, one student in B.S.C., Medical Laboratory Technology and six students in B.Sc., Operation Theatre and Anesthesia Technology. The petitioner college admitted the students within the last date of admission (i.e) 30.12.2024. The College sent the students list to the first respondent / University on 21.12.2024. Thereafter the College requested the University to provide it with CMS2 Institution login credential for R1 and R2 Login to enroll / register the students as the last date for link registration was 28.03.2025. However, the 1st respondent/ University did not provide the same. Hence, the petitioner prayed for the interim direction.



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4. *The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that today is the last date for online registration of the students particulars and therefore, unless and until the petitioner College is provided with the login credentials to register the students, it would cause great hardship to the students and the College. He further submitted that no prejudice would be caused to the respondent University in as much as the number of students admitted was well within the approved intake granted by the University.*

5. *Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the respondents and perused the materials placed before this Court.*

6. *It is seen that though the Government vide G.O.(Ms)No.382 dated 21.11.2024, permitted an intake of 80 seats, in the four Allied Courses started by the petitioner College, the first respondent / University in its conditional provisional affiliation restricted the intake to 50 seats for the four courses. The petitioner College admitted only ten students for three courses and did not admit any student for one course. As the students are admitted within the permitted intake granted by the 1st respondent / University, as rightly contended by the learned counsel for the petitioner, no prejudice would be caused to the University by granting the interim relief.*

7. *I am therefore inclined to direct the respondents to provide college login credentials to the three Under Graduate Allied Health Sciences Subjects namely, B.Sc., Cardiac Technology, B.S.C., Medical Laboratory Technology and B.Sc., Operation Theatre and Anesthesia Technology, so as to enable the petitioner to register the students admitted in the aforesaid courses for the academic year 2024-2025 forthwith. Considering that today is the last date for online registration, the learned counsels for the petitioner and the respondent are directed to communicate this order to the first respondent / University immediately by Email. However, it is made clear that the direction issued herein is subject*



to the result of the writ petition.

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5. Pursuant to the above interim order, the 1st respondent University registered the students who had been admitted in the petitioner college for the academic year 2024-2025.

6. The admitted students had enrolled for the examination to be held in December 2025. For that purpose, the internal marks secured by those students must be uploaded and the examination fees has to be paid to the 1st respondent University through their portal.

7. The grievance of the petitioner is that the 1st respondent University has not opened the portal for the petitioner college to enter the internal assessment marks and for payment of the examination fees. It is under these circumstances, the present petition has been filed before this Court.

8. In the considered view of this Court, the students were admitted pursuant to the interim orders passed by this Court. Therefore, those students must be permitted to write the examination and for that purpose, the 1st respondent University has



to open the portal for the petitioner college to enter the internal assessment marks and for payment of examination fees. This will be without prejudice to the 1st respondent University to raise all the grounds in the writ petition. If such an interim order is not granted by this Court, no useful purpose will be served in granting earlier interim order pursuant to which those students were admitted in the petitioner college.

9. In the light of the above discussion, this Writ Miscellaneous petition is allowed as prayed for and it is also made clear that this direction is issued without prejudice to the rights of both sides to raise all the grounds in the main writ petition.

10. Post this writ petition for final hearing on 15.12.2025.
