ORDER

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest for the alleged offence under
Section 305(e) and 326(a) of BNS 2023 in Cr.No.257 of 2025 on the file of
the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.



2. The allegation against the petitioner is that on 28.09.2025 at about 03.00p.m., the petitioner joining with other accused had quarried one unit sand from Puthagaram Lake and had transported by using lorry bearing Registration No.TN-86-R-4615 without any valid licence from the Government of Tamilnadu. The respondent police seized the vehicle. Hence, the case.

3. Earlier, this Court after considering the various points, dismissed the anticipatory bail petition of the petitioner vide order dated 30.10.2025 in Crl.OP.No.29488 of 2025. The relevant portion of the order reads as follows:

“ Considering the fact that the petitioner had quarried the sand from lake and the same was transported illegally; that the petitioner has one previous case similar in nature; if the anticipatory bail grant to the petitioner he would in similar type of activities and he damaged the ecology and water body, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner”.

4. Subsequent to the dismissal of the above petition, the petitioner has filed the present petition on the very same grounds that were raised in the earlier bail petition. Further, there is no change in circumstances after the



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dismissal of earlier petition. Hence, this Court is not inclined to reconsider once again the merits of the claim made in the earlier bail petition.

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5. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
