PRAYER: Criminal Appeal is filed under Section 14(A)(2) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Amendment Act) Cr.P.C), to set aside the order dated 12.11.2025 made in Crl.M.P.No.360 of 2025 on the filed of Sessions Judge, Special Court For Exclusive Trial of Cases registered under the SC and ST (POA) Act, 1989 in connection with the crime number 33 of 2025 on the file of the 2nd respondent police by allowing this criminal appeal.

ORDER



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(i) The appellant shall deposit a sum of Rs.2,00,000/- to the credit of Crime No.33 of 2025, without prejudice to his rights and contentions, at the time of execution of sureties. On such deposit, the victim shall be permitted to withdraw the same.

(ii) The appellant shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Sessions Judge, Special for Exclusive Trial of Cases registered under the SC and ST(POA) Act, 1989:

(iii) the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the learned Judge may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(iv) the appellant / accused shall appear before the concerned Trial Court on every Monday at 10.00 a.m., until further orders and shall appear before the trial court on all hearing dates without fail;

(v) the appellant shall not commit any offences of similar nature;

(vi) the appellant shall not abscond either during



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investigation or trial;

(vii) the appellant shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(viii) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Trial Judge is entitled to take appropriate action against the appellant in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the appellant released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]*;
