ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on
18.09.2025, for the offence punishable under Sections 126(2), 296(b), 109,



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309(4), 351(3) of BNS in Crime No.298 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is that on 17.09.2025, petitioner waylaid the defacto complainant and demanded money, since the defacto complainant refused to give money, petitioner attacked the defacto complainant with knife, due to which, defacto complainant sustained grievous injuries. Hence, the case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He further submitted that, in four cases, petitioner got acquitted. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.



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4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that the in the alleged occurrence, none sustained injuries. He further submitted that, apart from this case, peititoner has 10 previous cases. Hence, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Though petitioner has 10 previous cases, considering the fact that no one sustained injuries in the alleged occurrence, and period of incarceration this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions:

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on their executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate No.I, Tiruvallur** and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of



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Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30.a.m., for a period of three weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a Police Officer as and when required;

[d] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly cause any threat to the de facto complainant and witnesses;

[e] the petitioner to give an undertaking that if required for being identified by witnesses during investigation or for police custody beyond the first fifteen days, he shall comply to the directions as may be given by the Court in this regard;

[f] On breach of any of the aforementioned



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conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
