PRAYER: Writ Petition (Criminal) is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a writ of Mandamus or direction in the nature of writ, to direct the third respondent to conduct an enquiry on the petitioner's representation dated 11.04.2025 and issue a Non-Traceable Certificate in respect of the original missing Document Nos.1299/1957, 1353/1979 and 1801/1996, which are registered in the office of the Sub-Registrar, Mettupalayam, within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

The present Writ Petition (Criminal) has been filed seeking a direction to the third respondent to issue a Non-Traceable Certificate, by considering the petitioner's representation dated 11.04.2025.

2. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondents and perused the materials available on record.

3. The issue involved in this case, namely, the issuance of Non-Traceable Certificate, has already been dealt with by this Court in Crl.O.P.Nos.4067 of 2022 etc. batch, vide order dated 29.04.2022, after adverting to several judgments of this Court and also the circular dated 01.04.2022 issued by the Director General of Police in RC.No.2029209/Gen 1(1)/2022.

4. Following the aforesaid order, this Court directs the petitioner to approach the third respondent Police and furnish all particulars



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as required under the aforesaid circular issued by the Director General of Police. On receipt of such particulars, the third respondent Police shall consider the same and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law.

5. With the above directions, this Writ Petition (Criminal) stands disposed of. No costs.
