ORDER

This writ petition has been filed to direct the first respondent to issue suitable directions to the Competent Authority to pass orders for giving effect post up-gradation together with pay on par with the petitioners' Junior in Finance Department in furtherance to implementation of the orders issued by the State Government in G.O.Ms.No.31, P&AR Department, dated



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01.03.2017 and consequent to the Government U.O. Note

Without expressing any opinion on merits of the writ petition, the first respondent is directed to issue directions to the Competent Authority to consider the case of the petitioners and pass orders on merits and in accordance with law, within a period of twelve weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
