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ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 12.10.2025 for the offences punishable under Sections 20, 25(1A) of Arms Act, 1959, in Crime No.329 of 2025, registered on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against this petitioner is that, he was found in possession of sword. Hence he was immediately apprehended and arrested in this case. Hence this case.

3. The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and the petitioner is in judicial custody since 12.10.2025; and that the petitioner is ready to abide by any stringent conditions that may be imposed by this Court and sought for bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) appearing for the respondent reiterated the prosecution case, submitted that the petitioner is having

against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions
have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned
Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down by the Hon'ble
Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW
5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can
be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
