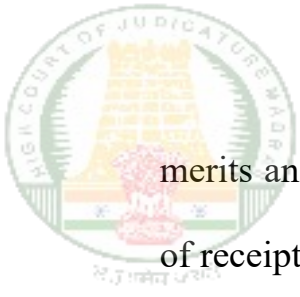

ORDER

2.Heard the learned counsel appearing on either side and perused the materials available on record.

3.Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the writ petition, the first and second respondents are directed to subject the petitioner to medical examination and pass appropriate orders regarding alternative employment on



merits and in accordance with law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, as per the medical report.

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4. With the above direction, this Writ Petition stands disposed of.
