ORDER

The Petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 13.10.2025 for the alleged offences punishable under Section 296(b), 115(2), 324(4), 85 of BNS & 4 of TNPHW @ 296(b), 115(2), 324(4), 85, 108 of BNS & 4 of TNPHW, in Crime No.34 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against this petitioner is that the A1/petitioner is husband of the deceased. A1 is having a habit of consuming alcohol and picking up quarrel with the defacto complainant, ill treated and torturing her. It is further alleged that on the date of occurrence, the petitioner along

with other relatives abused the deceased by using filthy language and also questioned her fidelity and attacked her, which caused insult to her and she committed suicide by setting herself on fire. Hence, the case.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner is the husband of the deceased he has accompanied with his mother for questioning the infidelity. He would further submit that the petitioner was arrested and he is in judicial custody from 13.10.2025 and is ready to abide by any conditions that may be imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police submitted that the petitioner is ranked as A1, he was arrested on 13.10.2025, investigation in this case is completed, and he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Though earlier bail petition of the petitioner was dismissed on 13.11.2025 in Crl.O.P.No.31074 of 2025 on the ground that investigation is not completed. Now it is reported by the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) that major part of the investigation is completed. Considering the submissions of the learned counsel on either side and the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *learned Judicial Magistrate, Additional Mahila Court, Coimbatore*, and



on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the Trial Court daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down
