ORDER



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The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 19.09.2025, for the offences punishable under Section 194(1) of BNSS @ 103(1) of BNS in Crime No. 296 of 2025 registered on the file respondent police, seeks bail.

2.The allegation against the petitioner is that the petitioner is the husband of the deceased. Due to the property dispute, he demanded money and collected to the tune of Rs.19,00,000/- from the de-facto complainant who is the father of the deceased. Subsequently, on the date of occurrence, he developed quarrel, demanded more money and strangled her and committed murder. Hence the case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody from 19.09.2025 and due to sudden quarrel the occurrence took place and the FIR was registered only on the basis of suspicion. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to



abide any condition imposed by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent police reiterated the prosecution case and submits that the petitioner who is the husband of the deceased, continuously harassed the deceased/victim on the date of occurrence and strangled her by using rope and committed murder. He further submits that the petitioner was arrested and remanded to judicial custody. He further submits that investigation is pending. However, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the fact that the period of incarceration of the petitioner from 19.09.2025 and it is also stated that the occurrence took place due to sudden quarrel, I am inclined to grant bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.



6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.20,000/- (Rupees Twenty Thousand only)** with **two sureties**, for a like sum to the satisfaction of the **learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Thirupattur**, and on further conditions that:

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the Application for Surety ship [Judicial Form No.46 annexed to 'The Criminal Rules of Practice, 2019']. The learned Magistrate shall obtain a copy of any one of the identity proofs to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall stay at Tiruchy and report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.III, Thirupattur, until further orders.

[c] On breach of any of the aforementioned conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to pass appropriate orders against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the aforementioned conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)13 SCC 283]**;



[d] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of B.N.S.
