ORDER

This Criminal Original Petition has been filed seeking a direction to the learned Sessions Division of Thirupathur District, Thirupathur, to accept the surrender of the petitioners in Crime No.163 of 2025, on the file of the second respondent and consequently consider the bail petition on merits on the same day in Crime No.163 of 2025, on the file of the second respondent police.

2. In view of the specific bar under Section 18 of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 and also taking into consideration the possibility of misusing the pious intention of the Parliament against innocent persons, there shall be a direction to learned Sessions Division of Thirupathur District, Thirupathur, to consider the petitioners' bail application,



preferably on the same day of their surrender in connection with Crime No.163 of 2025 on the file of the second respondent and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law, after affording due opportunity to the victims under Section 15-A of the SC/ST (POA) Act, 1989. The petitioners shall surrender before the jurisdictional Court, within a period of fifteen days from the date of the receipt of a copy of this order.

3. In view of the above, the Criminal Original Petition stands allowed.
