ORDER



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The revision petitioner is the auction purchaser who had taken out an application in E.A.No.241 of 2012 for delivery of possession, subsequent to his purchase of the property in the Court auction.

2.The grievance of the petitioner is that, despite of the delivery also ordered by the executing Court, the petitioner is unable to conclude the proceedings. Admittedly, the suit was filed in the year 2010 and the execution application was filed, by the auction purchaser, even in the year 2012. The Hon'ble Supreme Court, as time and again, held that the execution proceedings should not be delayed and should be disposed within a period of six months.

3.In the light of the above, I am inclined to direct the II Additional Sub Court, Coimbatore, to dispose of E.A.No.241 of 2012 in E.P.No.47 of 2011 in O.S.No.45 of 2010, by the end of February 2026. Accordingly, this Civil Revision Petition is disposed of. No costs.
