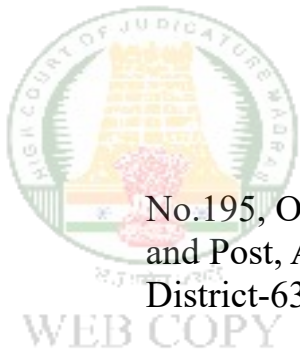

PRAYER in W.P. No.47919 of 2025: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying to issue a Writ of mandamus directing the respondents to pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 8 percent per annum for the belated payment of his provident Fund, Earned Leave salary, Gratuity and pension commutation Amount within a time limit to be stipulated by this Court.

COMMON ORDER

These writ petitions have been filed to direct the respondents to pay interest at 8% per annum for the belated payment of Provident Fund, Earned Leave Salary, Gratuity and Pension Commutation amount to the petitioners

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2. It is the case of the learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners joined as Conductor in the 1st respondent Corporation on 02.01.1998 and 21.02.1999 respectively, they were promoted as Special Grade Conductor and thereafter retired from service on 31.03.2024 and 31.01.2024 respectively. It is further stated that the provident fund, earned leave salary and gratuity amount were settled to the petitioners only on 25.08.2025. Therefore, the petitioners submitted a representation to the respondents on 15.09.2025 and 11.09.2025 seeking 8% interest on the belated settlement of retirement benefits, which has not been considered till date. Hence, the petitioners have approached this Court by way of these writ petitions.

3. Heard the learned counsels appearing on either side and perused the materials available on record.

4. In view of the limited request made by the petitioners with regard to interest on the belated settlement of retirement benefits, this Court directs the respondents to pay interest @ 6% for the belated payment of retirement benefits from the date of retirement till the date of actual disbursal of retirement benefits of the petitioners, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of a copy



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of this order taking into account the bank rate of interest on deposits.

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5. Accordingly, these Writ Petitions are disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.
