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ORDER

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 17.11.2025, for the alleged offence punishable under Section 281, 105, 238(b) and 240 of BNS Act, 2023 in Crime No.1101 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is that this petitioner driven the vehicle after drinking liquor, which resulted in accident and caused severe injuries to the passerby, and resulted in death. It is further alleged that the petitioner conspired with his father and produced his father as the driver of the vehicle, thereby attempted to screen the offence. Hence the complaint was lodged and both A1 and A2 were arrested.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner was arrested, and has been in judicial custody from 17.11.2025. He further submitted that the petitioner is first time offender with no previous cases, and the investigation in this case is completed. Hence, he prayed for grant of bail



to the petitioner.

4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police reiterated the prosecution case and submitted that the investigation in this case is pending. Hence, he opposed for grant of bail to the petitioner.

5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Considering the manner in which the occurrence had taken place, the petitioner is not having any previous cases and he is in judicial custody from 17.11.2025, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of **Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only)** with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the *learned Judicial Magistrate-I, Tiruppur*, and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left

Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain



a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks.

[c] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself, as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560];

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 B.N.S.
