When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 submitted that the petitioner had sent representations to the respondents 1 to 3. A similar complaint was also sent to the Chief.Minister's.Cell, which was forwarded for enquiry to the 3rd respondent. The petitioner's representation was enquired by the 3rd respondent in C.M.Cell No.13996892/2025. On enquiry, the 3rd respondent found that the matter is civil in nature and accordingly, closed the complaint.
