### **ORDER**

The petitioner, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on  
25.10.2025, for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 103(1), 109,



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115(2), 118(1), 296(b), 35(3) of BNSS in Crime No.256 of 2025, on the file of the respondent police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to property dispute, on 25.10.2025 the petitioner along with other accused attacked one of the co-accused mother and his family members with knife and deadly weapons. Due to which, the deceased had sustained fatal injuries and died on the spot. Hence, the case.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submitted that the case was registered based on the false complaint given by the defacto complainant and that the petitioner is an innocent and no way connected with the alleged offence. He would further submit that the petitioner was arrested and is in judicial custody from 25.10.2025. Hence, he prayed bail for the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police reiterated the prosecution of case and submitted that offences are grave in nature, investigation has almost completed and no previous cases against the petitioner. However, he opposed to grant bail to



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the petitioner.

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5. Heard both sides and perused the materials available on record including the First Information Report.

6. Considering the nature of offence, there is a property dispute between the parties and already investigation has been completed, no previous cases reported, considering the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner and also considering all others factors, this Court is inclined to grant bail to the petitioner, subject to certain conditions.

[a] Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned **Judicial Magistrate-II, Kanchipuram** and on further conditions that:-

**[b] the petitioner shall report before the learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Kanchipuram on all working days at 10.30 a.m., until further orders.**

[c] the petitioner shall not commit any offence similar to the offence of which he is accused, or suspected, or of the commission of which he is suspected;

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement,



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threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence;

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Judicial Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 BNS.
