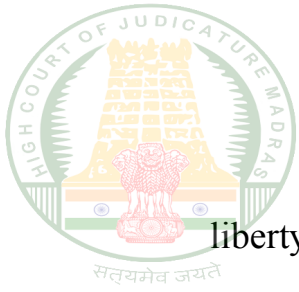

ORDER

The petitioner is the accused No.3 in Crime No.18 of 2023 registered on the file of the 1st respondent Police, for the offence under Sections 403, 420 IPC @ Section 403, 409, 468, 471, 420 and 120(b) of IPC and Sections 3(1)(q), 3(2)(vii) of SC/ST Act. Now, she has moved this petition to quash the FIR in Crime No.18 of 2023 registered against her.

2. Today, when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate (CrI. Side) submits that the investigation in Crime No.18 of 2023 has been completed and final report has also been filed before the PCR Court, Sivagangai, through e-filing in TNSVOE 0002762025 dated 17.06.2025.

3. Since it is reported that the final report has been filed in Crime No. 18 of 2023, without ascertaining the materials relied on by the investigating agency in the final report, this Court is not inclined to proceed with the available FIR. Therefore, this Criminal Original Petition is closed with

liberty to the petitioner to challenge the final report, if she is having any ground. Mere filing of the final report through e-filing is not sufficient. The respondent Police shall ensure that the final report is taken on file within a reasonable time. It is not only the responsibility of the respondent Police, the trial Court is also expected to take the final report on file, without any delay. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
