2.By consent of both parties, this writ petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.



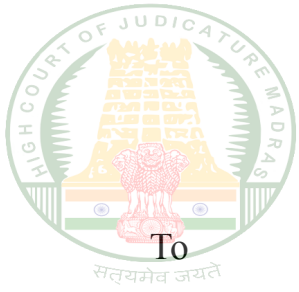
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3.The contention of the petitioner is that the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation buses in Tamil Nadu are in dilapidated condition, due to which many accidents are occurred. His further contention is that there are several irregularities by the officials of the Transport Corporation. The Tamil Nadu Transport Corporation is under heavy loss due to the poor maintenance of buses and the irregularities committed by the officials of the Corporation. By narrating all these facts, the petitioner made a representation dated 02.12.2024 to the respondents seeking to renovate the said buses. Since the said representation was not considered, the petitioner has filed this writ petition.

4.Perusal of the entire affidavit and after hearing the submissions made by the petitioner, this Court is of the view that the contentions raised by the petitioner in this writ petition are general in nature. The allegations levelled by the petitioner are omnibus. Hence, the same cannot be accepted. Accordingly, this writ petition is dismissed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.
