**PRAYER:** Writ Petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents to pay the difference amount of petitioner's retirement benefits such as wages, Pension arrears, gratuity and leave salary based on the 14<sup>th</sup> wage settlement under Section 12(3) of the ID Act dated 24.08.2022 along with 6% interest per annum.

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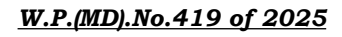
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## **ORDER**

The instant writ petition has been filed by a retired employee of the respondent transport corporation, seeking a mandamus to pay the difference amount of his retirement benefits, based upon the 14<sup>th</sup> wage settlement on 24.08.2022, and to pay arrears of Wages, Pension arrears, Gratuity and leave salary, Commuted Value of pension and the monthly pension along with dearness allowances along with interest.

2. According to the learned Counsel appearing for the writ petitioner, the petitioner was joined in the respondent Transport Corporation on 07.01.1985 and he had attained superannuation on 31.07.2022. He further contended that the 14<sup>th</sup> wage settlement was arrived on 24.08.2022. According to the petitioner, he is eligible to receive the said benefits and for revision of his pensionary benefits.

3. The petitioner has sent representation to the said effect on 16.12.2024. Since, there is no response from the respondents, the present writ petition has been filed.



5. With the above said observations, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.
