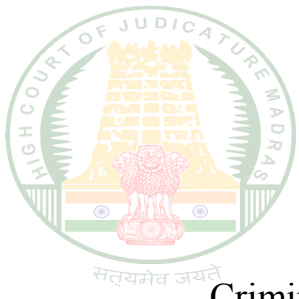

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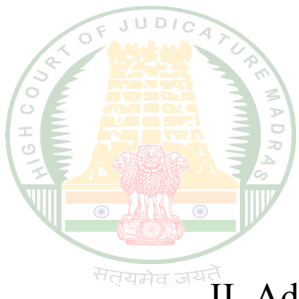

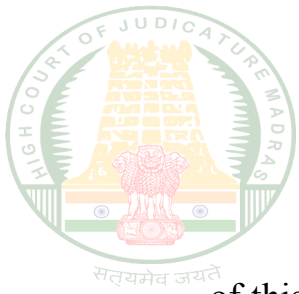

4. Mr.O.R.Gokul Abimanyu, learned counsel for the Petitioner submits that in view of the order passed by this Court dated 12.09.2025 in Crl.M.P.(MD)Nos.1590 and 1591 of 2025 in Crl.RC(MD)Nos.156 and 157 of 2025, he do not want to press these petitions and seeks permission



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of this Court to withdraw these Criminal Miscellaneous Petitions. He has also made an endorsement to that effect in the affidavit filed in support of the petition.

5. Mr.M.Karunanithi, learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) for the Respondent stated that he had no objection to the prayer made by the learned counsel for the Petitioner.
