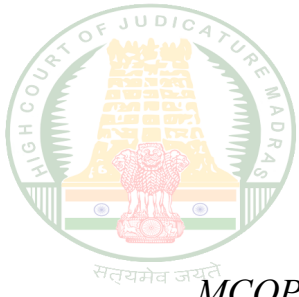

2. The learned counsel appearing for the revision petitioner submitted that while granting the interim order, dated 20.01.2026, this Court intended to grant four weeks’ time from the date of receipt of a copy of the order; however, in the said order, the time has been inadvertently mentioned as two weeks from today.

3. Considering the submission made by the learned counsel appearing for the revision petitioner, paragraph No.2 of the order passed in C.M.P.(MD) No.393 of 2026 in C.R.P.(MD) No.71 of 2026 shall stand substituted as follows:

4. Registry is directed to carry out necessary amendment in the said order and issue a fresh order copy to the parties.
