PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS Act.



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PRAYER:-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 200 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 294(b) and 324 of IPC, in Crime No.200 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that there was a civil dispute and the petitioners are said to have abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and attacked him. There are totally 10 accused persons in this case and the petitioners have been arrayed as A2, A3, A7 and A10.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4. Earlier all the ten accused persons approached this Court and filed CrI.OP (MD).No.8750 of 2024 and sought for anticipatory bail. This Court by an order dated 19.06.2024 granted anticipatory bail. The petitioners were not able to execute the sureties within the time frame fixed by this Court and hence, the anticipatory bail



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petition stood dismissed insofar as the petitioners are concerned. Hence, the present anticipatory bail petition has been filed before this Court.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the petitioners were already granted anticipatory bail and they were not able to get the sureties executed on time, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Theni, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two common sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.



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[b] the petitioners shall appear before the respondent Police as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023. IPC.
