Further I could not travel Tuticorin more than 106 kilometers in 3 hours. It is much difficult to go and attend the court. In the above said circumstances, it is just and necessary that this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to transfer the above HMOP from the court of learned Family Court, Coimbatore to the learned Family Court at Tuticorin for proper adjudication of the matter, otherwise I will be put to great loss and hardship.”
