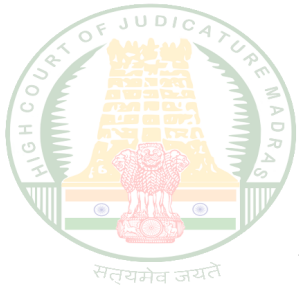
ORDER

This petition has been filed by the petitioner to quash the First Information Report in Crime No.12 of 2024 on the file of the first respondent police, for the offences under Sections 284, 304(A) of IPC and Sections 7,8 and 9 of Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013.

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned counsels on both sides represented that the matter has been amicably settled between the parties and to that effect, they have entered into a compromise and the same was filed before this Court.

3. The defacto-complainant and the accused are present and this Court enquired about the terms of compromise. The defacto-complainant represented that they entered into a compromise and he has no objection to quash the FIR. A compromise memo, dated 31.01.2025 signed by the parties and their respective counsel, is also filed before this Court.

4. This Court has perused the terms of the compromise memo.

5. The learned Government Advocate(Crl.Side) submitted that during last hearing due to inadvertence it was wrongly represented that the case was taken on file in STC No.472 of 2024. On verification no charge sheet was filed in this case. Further already the parties settled the matter between them and compromise memo was also filed.

6. Considering the nature of the offences and the relationship between the parties and though final report has been filed and the same is pending before the Court, filing of final report will no way affect the arriving of compromise between the parties, thereby, it is appropriate to allow this petition.

7. Recording the said compromise memo, this petition is allowed and the First Information Report in Crime No.12 of 2024 on the file of the first respondent police is quashed. The compromise memo dated 31.01.2025 filed by the parties shall form part of this order.
