PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS Act.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 685 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police.

WEB COPY ORDER: The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 147, 148, 294(b), 342, 323, 324 and 506(2) of IPC, in Crime No.685 of 2023 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that A1 and A2 were taking treatment in a DE addiction centre which was run by the defacto complainant. There used to be regular wordy quarrel with the defacto complainant. On the date of occurrence, the accused persons are said to have gone to the DE addiction centre and abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and threatened him with dire consequences and also attacked him. There are totally 8 accused persons in this case and the petitioner has been added as A3.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital and there

are no previous cases against the petitioner and also considering the fact that the FIR was registered in the year 2023, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

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5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on her appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.VI, Madurai, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police as and when required.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
