PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS Act.

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 204 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Sections 191(2), 296(b), 109 and 351(3) of BNS in Crime No.204 of 2024 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The earlier anticipatory bail petition filed by A1 to A2 was dismissed by this Court on the ground that there are previous cases against the petitioners, out of which, one case is for the offence under Section 302 of IPC. This application has been filed on the ground that, the said fact was incorrect.

3. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) on instructions submitted that, there is one previous case against A1 for the offence under Sections 294, 506(2) and 326 of IPC and there are no previous cases against A2.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and

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considering the fact that this Court had granted anticipatory bail to A3 to A6 in  
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Crl.O.P.No.21965 of 2024 by an order dated 20.12.2024 and considering the fact that  
petitioner has one previous case and there are no previous cases against A1 and  
taking note of the fact that the injured has been discharged from the hospital, this  
Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of  
arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which  
the order copy made ready, before the learned District Munsif Cum Judicial  
Magistrate Court, Ponnamaravathy, Pudukkottai on condition that the petitioners  
shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two  
sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police  
officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate  
concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and  
on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb  
Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar  
card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioners shall report before the respondent police on every



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Wednesday and Friday at 10.30.a.m., for a period of six weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioners in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
