PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS Act.

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COMMON PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 15 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police.

COMMON ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences under Section 288 of BNS, 2023 and Section 9(b)(1)(a) of the Indian Explosive Act 1884, in Crime No.15 of 2025 on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons had illegally manufactured crackers without any license and had stocked the same in the property. There are totally 3 accused persons in this case.

3. The learned Government Advocate submitted that A1 was already arrested in this case during the pendency of this petition. In view of the same, this petition is dismissed insofar as A1 is concerned.

4. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of

the case.



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5. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the illegally manufactured crackers have been seized and taking note of the fact that there are 8 previous cases against A2, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Manamadurai, Sivagangai, on condition that the petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail shall stand dismissed and on further condition that:

[a] the petitioners and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank Pass Book to ensure their identity.



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[b] the petitioner/ A2 shall report before the respondent Police on every Monday and Friday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of six weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner/ A3 shall report before the respondent Police as and when required for interrogation.

[d] the petitioners shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[e] the petitioners shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[f] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioners released on



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bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560].

[g] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
