PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.759/2024. on the file of the Respondent Police



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / A9, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the offences under Sections 420, 465 and 471 of IPC in Crime No.759 of 2024 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons created a non-traceable certificate by falsely claiming that the same was issued by the Police and using the same, they executed a sale deed in favour of the petitioner dated 23.02.2021. There are totally ten accused persons in this case and the petitioner has been arrayed as Accused No.9.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Criminal Side) appearing for the respondent Police.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner not only purchased an extent of 12 cents from Accused Nos.1 to 6 through sale deed dated 23.02.2021, he also purchased an extent of 12 cents from the wife and son of the defacto complainant through sale deed dated 08.09.2021 and that apart, there is a pending suit in O.S.No.39 of 2021 on the file of the



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District Munsif Court, Valliyoor. The petitioner is a subsequent purchaser of the property.

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5. In view of the above, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Valliyoor on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only), with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate, on further condition that:

[a] if the petitioner fails to surrender before the said Magistrate within a period of fifteen days, this order shall stand automatically cancelled;

[b] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation;

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during



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investigation or trial;

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[d]the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[e] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;

[f] if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS 2023.
