PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.482 of BNSS

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 6 of 2024 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence under Sections 406, 465, 468 and 420 IPC in Crime No. 6 of 2024



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on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

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2. The case of the prosecution is that A1 with the help of A3 promised the defacto complainant that he will get a job for his son in the Electricity Board and accordingly, a total sum of Rs.6 Lakhs was collected. Later, the job was not secured and the amount was also not repaid back. The allegations against the petitioner (A2) is that the entire amount was routed through the account of the petitioner.

3. Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent police.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that A3 was granted anticipatory bail by this Court in Crl.O.P (MD)No.18323 of 2024 by order dated 28.10.2024 and also considering the fact that A1 was arrested and later enlarged on bail and the fact that there are no previous cases against the petitioner and the only allegation is that the amount was routed through the account of the petitioner and the transaction had taken place in the year 2019, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this criminal original petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Tenkasi, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of



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Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the said Magistrate, on further condition that:

[a] if the petitioner fail to surrender before the said Magistrate within a period of fifteen days, this order shall stand automatically cancelled.

[b] the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[c] the petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required for interrogation.

[d] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

[e] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

[f] on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]; and;



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[g] if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under
Section 269 of BNS 2023.
