Prayer : Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus to direct the 2nd and 3rd respondents, to consider and dispose the petitioner's representation dated 07.10.2024, relating to restoration of the pay and for re-fixation of the petitioner's pension in accordance with the last drawn pay while in service at par with the petitioner's batch-mates and to repay the recovered amount Rs.62,883/- deducted from the petitioner's gratuity and to pay enhanced pension with all the arrears.

The Respondents are directed to serve a copy of the above said proceedings dated 27.01.2025 to the petitioner. No costs.
