PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the second respondent to conduct an



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inquiry under Section 9 of the Tamil Nadu Patta Pass Book Act, 1983 into the illegal patta transfer, further directing the third respondent to cancel the fraudulent patta's numbered as Patta NO.28 and subsequent patta No.1151, and further direct the third respondent to issue a joint patta in the name of all legal heirs of Mohammed Ibrahim within the period that may be stipulated by this Court.

ORDER

I have heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned Government Advocate appearing for the official respondents.

2. The writ petitioner seeks issuance of a writ of mandamus to dispose of the petitioner's representation, dated 20.12.2024.

3. According to the petitioner, his father was owning the subject lands and after his demise, one of his legal heirs, behind the back of the other legal heirs, proceed to obtain patta in his individual name. It



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is this patta, which is sought to be cancelled and recalled by way of the representation dated 20.12.2024.

4. Mr.C.Satheesh, learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents would submit that enquiry proceedings have already commenced and the next date of hearing is 21.02.2025, before the second respondent.

5. Considering the same, there shall be a direction to the second respondent to conclude the enquiry and pass final orders within a period of twelve weeks from date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, the writ petition is disposed of.
