PRAYER: Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondents 1 to 6 to conduct an



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enquiry based on the petitioner's representation dated 11.01.2025 after giving sufficient opportunity to the petitioner as well as the respondents 7 to 11 to avoid law and order problem and pass an order within a stipulated time which may be fixed by this Court.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed for a direction, directing the respondents 1 to 6 to conduct an enquiry based on the representation submitted by the petitioner dated 11.01.2025, alleging that the respondents 7 to 11 are attempting to demolish the private temple worshipped by the petitioner and others, viz., Sri Vinayagar temple situated in the land comprised in S.No.447/2 (old S.No.8/7) situated at K.Rayapuram, 115, Tirumayam Taluk, Pudukkottai District, to an extent of 67 cents.

2. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.



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3. It is seen that the respondents 7 to 7 are attempting to demolish the temple in order to construct new temple. However, the petitioner and other general public are objecting the same and also submitted representation to the respondents 1 to 6 herein.

4. Admittedly, it is a private temple and it is not coming under the purview of H.R & C.E Board. Therefore, the respondents 1 to 6 have no say in the dispute between the petitioner and the respondents 7 to 11 herein. However, there is any law and order issue, the petitioner is at liberty to lodge complaint before the sixth respondent. On receipt of the same, the sixth respondent is directed to deal with the complaint in accordance with law.

5. With the above direction, the writ petition stands disposed of. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
