PETITION FOR BAIL Under Sec.483 of BNSS

PRAYER :-

For Bail in Crime No. 14/2025. on the file of the respondent police.



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ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

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The petitioner / Accused No.2, who was arrested and remanded to judicial custody on 11.01.2025 for offences under Sections 310(4), 310(5) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25(1A) of Arms Act in Crime No.14 of 2025, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 11.01.2025 at about 12.30 hours, based on a secret information, the respondent Police went to the spot and found totally six persons, who were preparing to commit a dacoity in Panaiyur Co-operative Society and they were all armed with deadly weapons. There are totally six accused persons in this case and the petitioner has been arrayed as Accused No.2.

3. Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the material records of the case.

4. Taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the manner in which the prosecution has projected the case and taking note of the fact that there are two previous cases against the petitioner, this Court is



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inclined to grant bail to the petitioner subject to the following conditions:

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5. Accordingly, the criminal original petition is ordered and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivagangai and on further conditions that:-

[a] the sureties shall affix their photographs and Left Thumb Impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity.

[b] the petitioner shall report before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Sivagangai every Monday and Friday at 10.30 a.m. for a period of six weeks and thereafter, appear before the respondent Police as and when required for interrogation.

[c] the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial.

[d] the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial.

[e] On breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/Trial

Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with



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law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **P.K.Shaji vs. State of Kerala [(2005)AIR SCW 5560]**.

[f] If the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 269 of BNS, 2023.
