PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Mandamus, directing the respondent to pay the petitioner interest at the rate of 18% per annum, for the period of delay from 01.02.2023 to 29.10.2024, in paying the amounts paid towards his terminal and pension benefits namely EPF Employee's contribution, Gratuity and Encashment of Leaves and commutated value of pension of her deceased husband/retired



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employee (late) A.Muniasami, Staff No.5178, within a time frame as may be fixed by this Court and without affecting his right to claim balance amounts towards those benefits.

ORDER

This Writ Petition has been filed by the wife of the deceased employee seeking a writ of mandamus directing the respondent to pay interest at the rate of 18% per annum for the period of delay in paying the amount paid towards her husband terminal and pension benefits namely EPF, Gratuity and encashment of leave and commutated value of pension within a time frame that may be fixed by this Court without affecting the right to claim the balance amount towards those benefits.

2. The petitioner's husband was appointed as Sweeper in the first respondent Corporation on 05.02.1988 and he retired from service on 31.01.2023. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's



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husband terminal benefits was not settled immediately and there is an abnormal

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3. In view of the same, the only issue to be considered in this Writ Petition is with regard to interest payable on the belated settlement. This issue was dealt with by this Court on various occasions and this Court passed orders in several Writ Petitions. In fact, the issue involved in this writ petition is no longer *res-integra*.

4. This Court in W.P(MD)No.4866 of 2023 (C.MuruganVs. the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (Tirunelveli) Ltd., and Another) by order dated 07.03.2023 has decided this issue.

5. Accordingly, by following the order stated supra, this Writ Petition is allowed with the following direction:

The respondent shall pay interest to the petitioner at the rate of 6% per annum on the belated payment of the retirement benefits commencing from the date of retirement, till date of actual disbursement, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.
