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enhanced pension with all the arrears thereon within the time frame that may be stipulated by this Court.

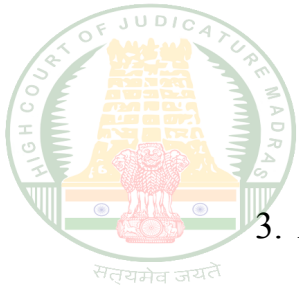
