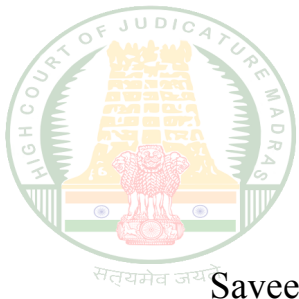

ORDER

When the matter was taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is a medical student seeking admission in Post Graduate (Dermatology) course at



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Saveetha Medical College, Chennai for the current academic year.

Therefore, the petitioner seeks an extension of the period to join the said course until the publication of the results of the counselling conducted by the fourth and fifth respondents for candidates to be admitted under the State Quota.

In response to the aforesaid submission, the learned Additional Government Pleader, as well as the learned Deputy Solicitor General appearing on behalf of respondents 1 to 3 submitted that the petitioner had already joined the course on the last date of admission and hence, the matter has now become infructuous.
