ORDER

Considering the limited scope of prayer sought for in this petition and the representation of the petitioner also under consideration by the third respondent, this Court without issuing notice to the private respondent inclined to dispose the writ petition by directing the third respondent to complete the enquiry within a period of one (1) week from the date of this order, in accordance with law.

4. With the above said observations and directions, this writ petition stands disposed of. There shall be no order as to costs.

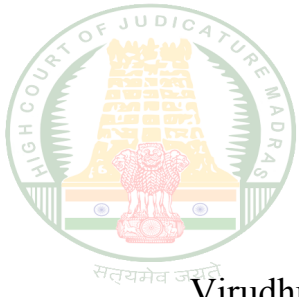
