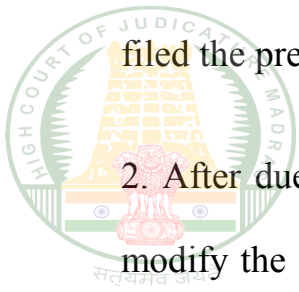

This case came up for settlement before the Lok Adalat. Both the parties present. The counsel for the appellant/s Mr. J. S. Murali and the counsel for the respondent/s Mr. Sudalayandi are present. After mutual discussion, negotiation, mediation and conciliation between both parties and with the assistance of the Bench, both sides consented for settlement.

AWARD

Aggrieved by the award passed by the Tribunal, the appellant / Insurance Company has



filed the present appeal.

2. After due deliberations, both the parties have entered into compromise and agreed to modify the award amount to a sum of Rs.42,50,000/- (Rupees Forty Two lakhs and Fifty Thousand only) as full quit. The appellant is directed to deposit the said award amount, after deducting the amount already deposited, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this award. On such deposit being made, the natural guardian of the minor petitioner namely Smt.Uma Maheswari is at liberty to withdraw a sum of Rs.20,00,000/- immediately for her medical expenses and the remaining amount shall be deposited in any one of the nationalised banks till the minor petitioner attains majority. The guardian/mother of the minor is permitted to withdraw the interest once in three months for the welfare of the minor petitioner.
