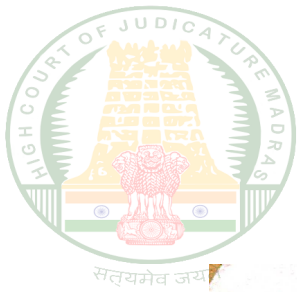

ORDER

The Criminal Revision Case is directed as against the order passed by the learned Family Court, Ramanathapuram in M.C.No.25 of 2021, dated 25.04.2022.

2. The petitioner herein is the husband and the respondents are his wife and children. When the matter was pending before the Court, the settlement agreement entered into between the petitioner and the respondents on 19.09.2024 before the Mediation Center and the same has been placed before me for my perusal.

3. A careful reading of the same would reveal that the petitioner husband has already deposited an amount of Rs.6,50,000/- in the name of the respondents 2 and 3 separately, i.e., a total amount of Rs.13,00,000/- in fixed deposit before the State Bank of India, Bharathi Nagar, Ramanathapuram. The settlement agreement, dated 19.09.2024 shall form part and parcel of the order and the same is extracted below:

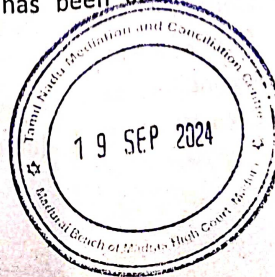

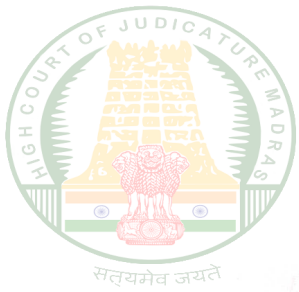
WHEREAS

1. Dispute and difference had arisen between the Parties hereto and Crl.R.C.(MD)No.397 of 2024 was filed on 16.02.2023 before The Madurai Bench of Madras High Court.
2. The matter was referred to mediation / conciliation vide an order dated 17.06.2024 passed by Hon'ble Mr. Justice .K.K.Ramakrishnan J
3. The parties agreed that Mr.N.Tamilmani would acts as their Mediator/ Conciliator.
4. Several meetings were held during the process of Mediation / Conciliation from 19.06.2024 to 19.09.2024 and the parties have with the assistance of the Mediator / Conciliator voluntarily arrived at an amicable solution resolving the above mentioned disputes and differences.
5. The parties hereto confirm and declare that they have voluntarily and of their own free will arrived at this Settle Agreement in the Presence of the Mediator / Conciliator.

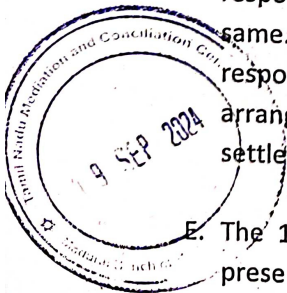

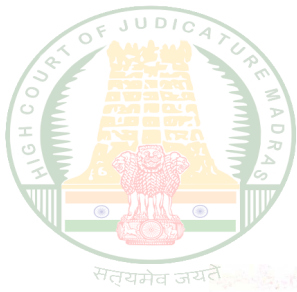

- A. Both parties agreed for filing Divorce by mutual consent petition before the proper court of law, since there is no possibility of re-union between them. Both parties agreed to co-operate with each other for the steps taken for getting Degree of Divorce by mutual consent.
- B. The petitioner/husband agreed to handover the household articles belonged to the 1st respondent/wife at the time of filing petition for divorce by mutual consent. The 1st respondent/wife is agreed for the same.
- C. The 1st respondent/wife handed over Golden Thaali (Mangal Sutra) weighing 10 grams to the petitioner/husband and received Rs.65,000/- as cash from the petitioner/husband as the value of 10 grams of Gold.
- D. The petitioner/husband deposited Rs.6,50,000/- each (total Rs.13,00,000/-) in the name of minor 2nd and 3rd respondents in fixed deposit before the State Bank of India, Bharathi Nagar, Ramanathapuram vide A/c.No's. 43355970339 and 43356328073. He nominated the 1st respondent/wife as the guardian of said minors and the 1st respondent is entitled to receive the interest for the above fixed deposits every month. Today the petitioner/husband handed over the original fixed deposit receipts in the name of minor 2nd and 3rd respondents to the 1st respondent/wife. The 1st respondent/wife after verifying the above receipts accepted the same. Only After the attainment of age of majority the 2nd and 3rd respondents are entitled to get the deposited amount. The arrangement is arrived between the parties as full and final settlement.
- E. The 1st respondent/wife agreed that she will not claim any past, present and future maintenance from the petitioner/husband. Further, the respondents have no objection to set aside the order passed in M.C.No.25 of 2021 dated 25.04.2022 passed by the

Honorable Family Court, Ramanathapuram by allowing the Crl.R.C(MD)No.397 of 2024 pending before the Honorable Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court as per the terms and conditions of the settlement agreement. The respondents agreed to not press the execution application in Cr.M.P.No. 757 of 2022 filed by them before the Honorable Family court, Ramanathapuram.

F. The petitioner/husband agreed that he will not claim guardianship or visitation right of the minors 2nd and 3rd respondents until they attain the age of majority. He agreed that minor 2nd and 3rd respondent may be in the custody of the 1st respondent/wife.

7. By signing this Agreement the Parties hereto state that they have no further claims or demands against each other with respect to Crl.R.C.(MD)No.397 of 2024 and all disputes and difference in this regard have been amicably settled by the Parties hereto through the process of Conciliation / Mediation.

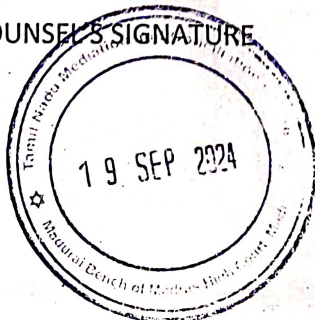
