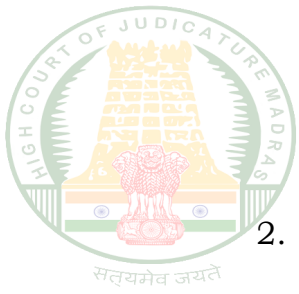

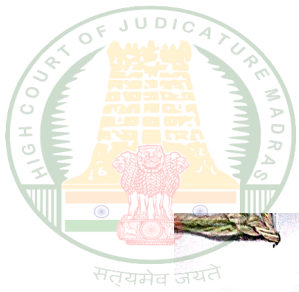

2. When the matter was taken up for hearing today, i.e., on 26.08.2025, both parties appeared before this Court. A compromise has been arrived at between the parties and the joint compromise memo has also been filed before this Court. They have agreed to resolve the indifferences and settle the matter in terms of the joint compromise entered into between them on 26.08.2025.

3. The respondent wife agreed to receive a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- as one time settlement from the petitioner towards permanent alimony. Pursuant to the same, a demand draft bearing D.D.No.208667, dated 22.08.2025, has been drawn by the petitioner in favour of the respondent. The respondent handed over the “Thirumangalyam” to the petitioner in terms of the joint compromise memo. The parties are strictly directed to comply with the condition without any deviation. 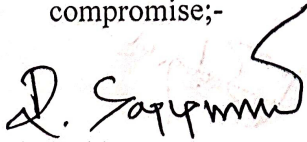

PETITIONER/RESPONDENT

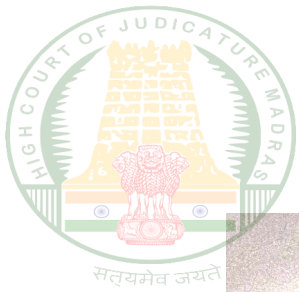
It is respectfully submitted that:-

Now both the petitioner and the respondent after various rounds of deliberations have arrived at a settlement on the following terms of compromise:-

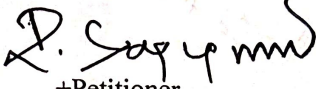

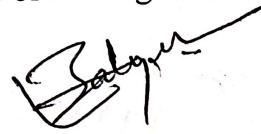

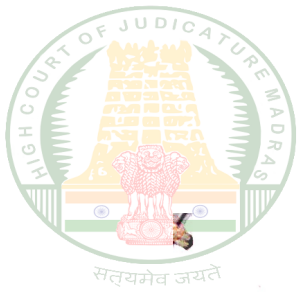

1. The petitioner and the respondent now in order to give quietus to the issue and for the welfare of their future decided to part away and settled their matrimonial dispute amicably between them.
2. It is submitted that as per the direction of this Hon'ble Court, the petitioner had already handed over all the jewels, ornaments and other household articles to the respondent. The respondent also acknowledges the receipt of the same. It is further agreed by the respondent that she will hand over the "Thirumangalyam" to the petitioner. Other than the said "Thirumangalyam" there is no such jewels or articles left to be returned by both the parties.
3. The respondent hereby agreed to receive a sum of Rs.7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs only) from the petitioner as One Time Settlement towards her permanent alimony and the petitioner is also hereby agreed to pay the said amount. In pursuant to the same, the petitioner drawn a Demand Draft bearing D.D.No.208667 dated 22.08.2025 drawn on Central Bank of India, Nagercoil Branch. Apart from the said amount, no other amount is to be paid by the petitioner to the respondent and vice versa.
4. The respondent has agreed to withdraw the petition filed by her against the petitioner in Cr.M.P.No.5 of 2025 in M.C.No.29 of 2022 pending before the Hon'ble Family Court, Tirunelveli and also the petition filed by her before the Learned Judicial Magistrate No.1, Tirunelveli in D.V.C.No.45 of 2023 against the petitioner and others.

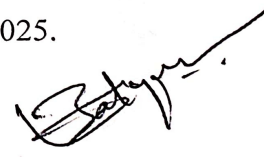

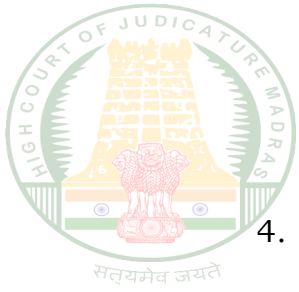
