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ORDER

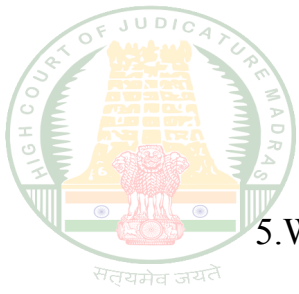
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The plaintiff in O.S.No.39 of 2024, on the file of the Sub Court, Sattur, is the revision petitioner herein.

2.The said suit was dismissed for default on 29.11.2024. For restoration of the suit, an application came to be filed within 30 days. However, the said application was returned by the office, raising certain objections with regard to the pleadings in paragraph Nos.5 and 6 of the said affidavit.
