ORDER

2.Heard the learned counsel on either side and perused the materials available on record.

3.According to the petitioner, the petitioner has lodged a complaint as against the 5th respondent for illegal fishing in Veerankulam situated at Kattakamanpatti, Nilakottai Taluk and Dindigul District. However, the same was not considered. Hence, this writ petition has been filed.



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4.The learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondent No.4 would submit that after receipt of the complaint of the petitioner, dated 15.02.2025, they had forwarded the same to the 3rd respondent.

5.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondents 1 to 3 would submit that after the receipt of complaint of the petitioner from the 4th respondent, the 3rd respondent is conducting enquiry in CSR No.169/2025 and the same is pending.

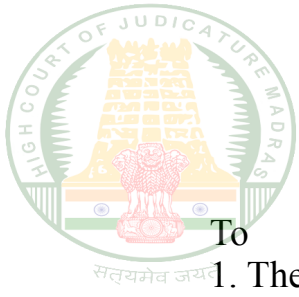
