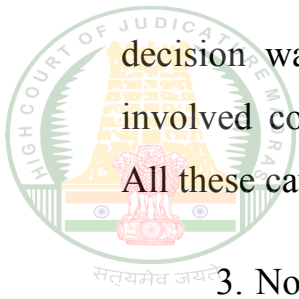

ORDER

2. In the affidavit filed in support of the petition, it had been contended that the orders have been passed in W.A.(MD)No.897 of 2018 on 05.08.2024 and the Web e-copy has been received on 15.08.2024 and thereafter, the Departmental
