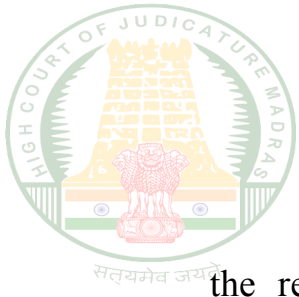

ORDER

The writ petition has been filed challenging the impugned proceedings passed by the second respondent dated 16.11.2021 as confirmed by the first respondent in his proceedings dated 26.11.2022 and consequently, for a direction to the respondents to reinstate the petitioner into service together with all consequential service and monetary benefits.

2. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Additional Government Pleader, appearing on behalf of the respondents 1 and 2. By consent of both parties, the Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the admission stage itself.

3. Today, when the matter was taken up for hearing, the learned Additional Government Pleader, who accepts notice on behalf of



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the respondents 1 and 2 produced the proceedings of the Director General of Police, Tamil Nadu – first respondent in Rc.No. 8688458/API(2)/2024, dated 10.02.2025. He submitted that the petitioner filed a review petition, which is still pending before the Additional Chief Secretary, Home Department, Chennai and therefore, nothing survives for adjudication in the present writ petition. The said submission and the proceedings dated 10.02.2025 have not been refuted by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. Recording the said submission of the learned Additional Government Pleader, this Writ Petition stands closed. No costs.
