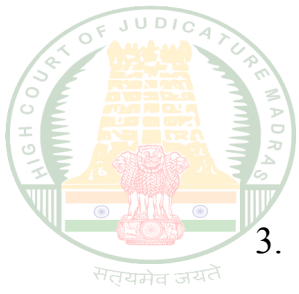

ORDER

This writ petition has been filed against the enquiry notice dated 21.02.2025, issued by the second respondent. During the course of enquiry, the second respondent has issued a notice dated 21.02.2025, instructing the petitioner to attend enquiry, to be held on 25.02.2025. Against the said notice, the petitioner filed this present writ petition.

2. Mr.D.Sachikumar, the learned Additional Government Pleader appearing for the respondents, on instructions submits that pursuant to the impugned notice dated 25.02.2025, the petitioner has attended the enquiry on 25.02.2025. On 26.02.2025, the competent authority has passed order and dropped all the charges against the petitioner.
