Prayer in WP(MD).No.9916 of 2024:-

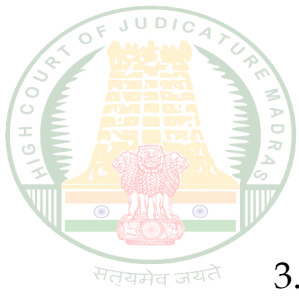

ORDER:-

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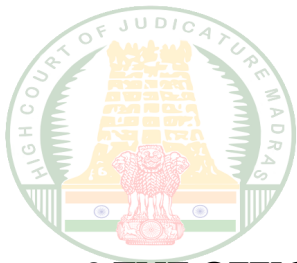
