ORDER

[Order of the Court was made by *J.NISHA BANU, J.*]

By consent of both parties, this Writ Petition is taken up for final disposal at the stage of admission itself.

2.It is the grievance of the petitioner that his representations dated 06.01.2025 & 08.02.2025, seeking removal of the encroachment made by the 4th respondent in the common pathway / cart track comprised in Survey No.163/22 situated at Paramanagar, Vadakadu & Post, Alangudi Taluk, Pudukkottai District, are kept pending till date without any progress. Therefore, he has filed this Writ Petition, seeking for a direction to the respondents 1 to 3 to remove the encroachment made by the 4th respondent.

3.Mrs.D.Farjana Ghoushia, learned Special Government Pleader, who takes notice on behalf of the respondents 1 to 3, submits that the representations

of the petitioner would be considered and appropriate orders would be passed on its own merits within a period that may be stipulated by this Court.

4. Notice to the 4th respondent is hereby dispensed with, since no adverse order is going to be passed as against him.

5. Considering the limited scope of the prayer sought for by the petitioner, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the claim made by the petitioner either in the representations or in the affidavit filed in support of this Writ Petition, we direct the official respondents to consider the representations of the petitioner dated 06.01.2025 & 08.02.2025, after giving sufficient opportunity of hearing to all the parties concerned and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of twelve [12] weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above direction, this Writ Petition is disposed of. No costs.
